a. Webinar "Study program in telecommunications" (M6.5)


The Webinar "Study programs in telecommunications", hosted by the University of Banja Luka and technically supported by the University of Belgrade, was held on May, 23rd, 2018, from 12:16 pm to 01:48 pm.

The main aim of the webinar was to present telecommunication study programs at the universities from Western Balkan countries that are the partners in the BENEFIT project. A representative from industry (Prointer, Banja Luka) gave the vision of industry needs and employment opportunities in the area of telecommunications in the local industry. Additional training possibilities, possibilities to continuation of studies and careers opportunities, not only in the region than broader, have been discussed, and concrete examples from the University of Novi Sad were presented. Student mobility opportunities were also discussed. Professors, students and industry representative from Banja Luka, Sarajevo, Belgrade, Novi Sad and Nis took a part in discussion. The number of participants was 12.

All project partners and students were invited to participate and distribute information about the webinar. Participants had possibility to register and participate online using Cisco Webex Collaboration tool. The webinar was devoted to the studying telecommunications engineering at the School of Electrical Engineering, University of Belgrade(UB-ETF).

The development of the telecommunications industry and needs for telecommunications engineers were presented. The impact of Erasmus+ project BENEFIT and activities performed at the UB-ETF were also presented. An introduction to the new modernized accredited modules on Bachelor's and Master's study programs, Information and Communication Technologies, has been provided.
