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1. Introduction

A description of the scopes and dissemination activities carried out for each webinar is reported in the following.

a. Webinar "Study programme in telecommunications"

The Webinar "Study Programmes in Telecommunications", hosted by the University of Banja Luka and technically supported by the University of Belgrade, was held on 23 May 2018, from 12:16 pm to 01:48 pm.

The main aim of the webinar was to present telecommunication study programmes at the universities from Western Balkan countries that are the partners in the BENEFIT project. A representative from the industry (Prointer, Banja Luka) presented the vision of industry needs and employment opportunities in the area of telecommunications in the local industry. Additional training possibilities, possibilities to continue studies and career opportunities, not only in the region but broader, have been discussed, and concrete examples from the University of Novi Sad were presented. Student mobility opportunities were also discussed. Professors, students and industry representatives from Banja Luka, Sarajevo, Belgrade, Novi Sad and Niš took a part in discussion. The number of participants was 12.

All project partners and students were invited to participate and distribute information about the webinar. The webinar was devoted to the studying telecommunications engineering at the School of Electrical Engineering, University of Belgrade (UB-ETF).

The development of the telecommunications industry and needs for telecommunications engineers were presented. The impact of the Erasmus+ project BENEFIT and activities performed at the UB-ETF were also presented. An introduction to the new modernized accredited modules on Bachelor's and Master's study programmes, Information and Communication Technologies, has been provided.
